Previous teaching experience and Wall Street (or similar) experience is desirable but not required. An MA, MS, MBA, or JD is required (a PhD in Finance (or similar) is desired, but not required). The primary job responsibilities include teaching 2-4 courses per semester at the undergraduate and graduate level in finance and working with industry partners on programming and placement of our finance students. The number of courses and other assigned duties will be determined by the Chair based on the candidates experience and areas of expertise. The assignment may be adjusted annually based on needs and performance. The projected start date is August of 2022, and the position will be open until filled.
