Based on our Hamilton campus you will produce research of a high standard in your specialist area of human resource management, and actively communicate the impact of that research within the Division and beyond. In addition to teaching a range of undergraduate and postgraduate subjects, you will supervise Honours, Masters and PhD students in their academic journey.

This is a full-time position (37.5 hours a week). Salary will be in the range from \$87,500 to \$104,322 per year for the lecturer role, \$107,177 to \$140,599 per year for the senior lecturer role, and \$142,358 to \$157,018 for the Associate Professor role. Salary will be dependent on the skills, knowledge and experience brought to the position.
