This is a nine-month assignment to initially span two academic years and is renewable. The ideal candidate will have a Ph.D. in social entrepreneurship (or related field) with 10 or more years of relevant experience. The Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business (AACSB) accreditation guidelines now include sustainability and social entrepreneurship across business education, emphasizing strategic planning, curricula, and research that yield positive societal impact. This approach directs business programs to address global issues such as poverty, climate change, and health disparities. In addition to teaching, this position will focus on AACSB standards related to social entrepreneurship, corporate social responsibility, and corporate sustainability.
