- 4. Develop, plan and execute new CSCI initiatives complementary to the mission of the center.
- 5. Collaborate with the Director of Recruiting and Outreach to develop and expand industry connections and secure sponsors to support CSCI research, professional development, training, certificate development, and educational initiatives.
