This nine-month position is designed to support the Global Programs of Auburn University's Harbert College of Business.

**Responsibilities:** The primary responsibility of this position is to teach undergraduate and graduate international business courses, assist in developing and delivering study abroad programs, and support the growth of international linkages with elite institutions worldwide. are candidates with an industry or governmental agency background. Under typical circumstances, the teaching load for the position will be three to four courses per semester, which includes course development and course management activities. In addition to instructional duties, successful candidates will be expected to help develop, promote, and lead study abroad programs at both the undergraduate and graduate levels. Candidates should be comfortable teaching different modalities, both domestically and internationally, including face-to-face, online, and hybrid. Salary and rank are commensurate with experience.
