or agriculture-related topics targeting leading journals in supply chain management. The applicant is also expected to demonstrate strong teaching abilities. Communicating effectively with prospective and current students, industry personnel, and the wider community is essential to this position. The expected start date for this position is August 2026.

Required Minimum Qualifications:

- Applicants must be a full professor (or equivalent) or be clearly qualified for promotion to full professor by Iowa State University standards.

- Candidates must meet the college's standards to be Scholarly Academic qualified under AACSB standards.
- Clear evidence of strong research potential in food- or agriculture-related topics in supply chain management.
